

VOLUNTEERS NEEDED!

Volunteers are what drive the Ellensburg Youth Baseball and Softball (EYBS) program. ANYONE interested in helping with the 2010 baseball/softball season in any position is required to fill out the volunteer form on the back of this page and turn it in to the appropriate player agent. Following is a brief description of positions:

HEAD COACH—A Head Coach has the primary responsibility of dealing with players and parents. He/she has final decision in all baseball and/or softball matters for his/her team. The Head Coach is required to attend EYBS coaches meetings and take an online coaching certification course, if he/she hasn't already done so. This course is offered anytime online. Once you've received this certification, you do not need to take the course again.

ASSISTANT COACH—An Assistant Coach has the responsibility of helping the Head Coach. Assistant coaches are required to attend EYBS coaches meetings and take an online coaching certification course. This course is offered anytime online. Once you've received this certification, you do not need to take the course again.

TEAM ORGANIZER—A Team Organizer's role is to assist the Head Coach and Assistant Coach by organizing and disseminating information to team parents regarding practice schedules, games, etc. Communication is often done in person, or via telephone and email.

SCOREKEEPER (Boys Minors/Majors and Girls Majors)—The Scorekeeper is responsible for maintaining the scorebook for his/her team and, for baseball, the Scorekeeper also tracks pitch counts for each game. Please contact the baseball player agent if training is needed.

PITCH COUNTER (Boys Minors/Majors only)—The Pitch Counter's role is to keep count of all pitches for each player on his/her team. One pitch counter will be provided per team. Each Pitch Counter must know the limits each pitcher can throw per game.

UMPIRE—Umpires are needed for boys major/minor and girls major games. Positions are behind the plate and in the field. The umpire position is a paid position. For more information, please contact the appropriate player agent

FIELD HELP—Extra help is always needed to help prepare fields before and after games. If you're interested in helping prepare fields, talk to your team's Head or Assistant Coach.

FUNDRAISER ORGANIZER—Each team may assign its own volunteer to organize the EYBS fundraiser for their players and work directly with the EYBS Fundraiser Coordinator.

ANYONE who is volunteering in ANY WAY for EYBS MUST complete and turn in the Volunteer Form on the back of this form, as well as fill out and turn in a Background Check consent form, which can be found at www.ellensburgbaseball.com.
